

# ARCH Foundation Course: The SEEN™ Keystones Information Details

# **Course description**

This self-paced online course introduces participants to the ARCH framework—a trauma-informed, story-centered facilitation model grounded in social constructionist therapies, including Narrative Therapy, Collaborative Therapy, and Solution-Focused Therapy. The framework is built around four core elements known as the SEEN™ Keystones: Sense of Self, Empowering Mindset, Externalizing Story, and Natural Flow. Each keystone draws upon evidence-based principles to enhance emotional safety, psychological flexibility, and client empowerment.

Participants will gain practical intervention tools designed to help clients explore, reshape, and transform their personal narratives. Emphasis is placed on establishing a trauma-informed and emotionally safe environment as the foundation for meaningful therapeutic engagement. The course includes demonstrations and guidance for applying the SEEN framework across a variety of settings—including telehealth and utilizing equine and nature-based environments.

This course is the foundational training and required prerequisite for professionals seeking certification through Arenas for Change (ARCH).

# **Target Audience**

This course is designed for licensed mental health professionals, including social workers, counselors, marriage and family therapists, psychologists, and related practitioners. It is also appropriate for facilitators incorporating experiential or equine-assisted and nature-based methods within their professional scope of practice.

## **Learning Objectives**

Upon completion of this course, participants will be able to:

- 1. Describe the theoretical foundations of the ARCH framework and its integration of narrative, collaborative, and solution-focused approaches.
- 2. Identify and apply the four SEEN Keystones (Sense of Self, Empowering Mindset, Externalizing Story, and Natural Flow) in therapeutic and facilitative contexts.
- 3. Demonstrate how to create an emotionally safe, trauma-informed environment that supports psychological safety and engagement.
- 4. Apply story-based intervention tools that support clients in exploring and shifting personal narratives.
- 5. Adapt the ARCH framework for use in telehealth, nature-based, and equineassisted environments.
